Hole deviation as follows: At 2785' off 1/2 of 1 degree; at 2810' off 3/4 of 1 degree; at 2840' off 1-3/4 degrees; at 2870' off 2-1/2 degrees; at 2900' off 3-1/4 degrees; at 2930' off 3-3/4 degrees; at 2960' off 4 degrees; at 2998' off 4-1/4 degrees; and 3030' off 5-1/2 degrees.
