Dear Mr. Payne:

We represent Mrs. K. A. Yoder of this city regarding the above described matter. The U.S.F. & G. has been given until the 15th of May, 1960, within which to plug a well located on the above described tract. For the last week we have been trying to work out an arrangement with the U.S.F. & G. with respect to the land owner assuming the responsibility for the plugging of the well and its conversion to a water well. We have not been able to complete our negotiations and probably will not be able to complete them before May 15, and we would like to ask you to extend the time for the plugging of the well for a period of thirty days from May 15, 1960. In the event we are unable to dispose of the matter by settlement, we will proceed to let the surety company plug the well in accordance with the requirements of your Oil Conservation Commission Office in Artesia.
