Your letter of June 30th. 1956 of refusal to approve new location in center of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 27 T3S, 24E, is not according to the understanding we had in your office after the the survey showed the old Warmen well on the wrong forty. Due to that fact and according to my understanding you would ask Mr. Ward to transfer the bond in my name, not Etz Bros. to cover the work we had started on the clean-out of the Warmen # 1. At that time I also explained that my Brothers had sold their interest in the deal and H.W. Etz was owner and operator, therefore I presumed the plugging bond was already in order for this location, as we had abandoned and plugged the old well on the same forty. I feel that the one bond should be sufficient to this particular well as you know we lost quite a sum of money in our failure to get to bottom in the old well. If do not con-cur on the understanding that is set out in this letter, please check and see whether or not the approval on the old Warmen #1 was approved after survey was made, it could be mistaken.
