Dear Sir:

I am withholding approval of your Notice of Intention to Drill the above captioned well for the following reasons:

1. The location of this wildcat well does not conform with Paragraph (b) Rule 104 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Rules and Regulations, which states that any well classified as a wildcat shall be located within 100 feet of the center of the 40-acre subdivision (only the Secretary of the Commission at Santa Fe has the authority to grant an exception to this rule).
2. Since this well site is within the boundary of the Roswell-Artesian Water Basin, I don't believe your proposed intermediate string of 8 5/8" casing mudded in @ 1350' and not cemented to completely cover the Artesian water strata will conform with the regulation of the Ground Water Supervisor of the State Engineer's office in Roswell.

I am enclosing the forms that you must file (Application to Drill for Oil) with the District Supervisor of the Roswell-Artesian Water Basin at Roswell. I suggest that you call Mr. E. G. Minton, Jr. and discuss your casing program with him, and then refile your Notice of Intention to Drill with a surveyor's plat in triplicate attached.
