This is in further reply to your letter of April 9th, with recard to the bond covering the L. B. Tannehill Well No. 1, Sec. 15, W. 12 S., R. 24 E.

Complying with my request, Mr. J.s. P. Sullivan, State Oil and Cas Inspector for southeastern New Merico has made an investigation of this well. He reports that the well is apparently properly plugged. However, before the bond can be released, we must have an official report on result of abandonment accompanied by a log of the well. As soon as proper papers are received from Mr. Sullivan, the well can be considered as finally abandoned and the bond released. We will notify you in this connection at the earliest possible moment.
