IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

SWD 202 1-20-78

That the applicant herein, Petroleum Corporation of Texas, is hereby authorized to complete its Mary Ann Cannon Well No. 8Y located in Unit N of Section 27, Township 10 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation at approximately 850 feet to approximately 917 feet through 2 3/8 inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 844 feet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the operator shall take all steps necessary to ensure that the injected water enters only the proposed injection interval and is not permitted to escape to other formations or onto the surface.

That the casing-tubing annulus shall be loaded with an inert fluid and equipped with a pressure gauge at the surface or left open to the atmosphere to facilitate detection of leakage in the casing, tubing, or packer.

That injection pressures shall not exceed 185 pounds per square inch as measured at the surface.

That the operator shall notify the supervisor of the Commission's Artesia District Office before injection is commenced through said well.

That the operator shall immediately notify the supervisor of the Commission's Artesia District Office of the failure of the tubing, casing, or packer in said well or the leakage of water from or around said well and shall take such steps as may be timely or necessary to correct such failure or leakage.
