FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Propose to rip 5" O.D. pipe at 800' and 7" at 600'. Pump mud through drill pipe and obtain mud returns from 800' to surface. Set drill pipe at 630' on top of 5" pipe and pump 20 sacks cement under pressure to 800'. Pull drill pipe to 600' and pump 20 sacks cement in at that depth. Run 10 sacks cement at surface. Use approximately 20 tons of mud in the operation.
