## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

We put a bridge into the 8 1/2" and put 10 sacks of cement on top of that; and had a perfect shutoff when we knocked the pipe off- We were only able to recover 300' out of 625' that was put in the well and the well was filled up with 100' of mud on top of the 8" and we are leaving the 10" in the hole for water well purposes as the land owners intention is to make a surface water well of it.




