Dear Mr. Hunter:

According to the newspapers of the last few days some oil has been struck in the Evans # 1 Well of the Warman Oil Syndicate in Sec. 15, T. 14 S., R. 25 E.

You will, of course, recall our previous correspondence with reference to this well particularly in connection with the fact that no bond has ever been filed at this office. If this well really gives promise of developing into a commercial oil well, it is especially important that a proper bond be filed here.

Will you kindly get in touch with the proper officials of this company and make an especially strong request that a proper bond be supplied. If this is not done in the near future, it may be necessary for us to take some drastic action.

It appears the only forms of the State Geologist which have ever reached this office for the Evans No. 1 Well are Form SG-101, "Notice of Intention to Drill" and Form SG-107 "Operator's Monthly Report of Operations" for August, September, November and December, 1931. I suggest that you do what you can to obtain back forms that are due. Obviously, this is a pretty tough assignment.
