Dear Sir:

Regarding your well that you are drilling in Sec.  
9, T. 14 S., R. 25 E.

At the time you wanted to shoot the well which  
was later plugged in Sec. 15, T. 14 S., R. 25 E. you promised  
me that you would get your bond fixed up in the very near fu-  
ture if I would let you go ahead and shoot, which I did to  
help you out. Then when you were getting ready to start the  
present well you said you would fix the bond if I would send  
you a copy of the approved form, which I did on the third of  
October. As yet I haven't received the bond, which I should  
have had two months ago.

I have obtained permission from the department to  
accept bonds in the amount of \$1500.00 for operators like  
yourself, where you do not expect to drill below 2000'. I  
did this to try and make it as light as possible on operators,  
but you apparently do not care to take advantage of it.

If I do not receive this bond before you start up  
again or within the next ten days it will be necessary for me  
to report this to our legal department for action.
