Dear Dr. Wells:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of February 23rd regarding the Garman well.

I have the "Notice of Intention to drill" for this well which I have been holding, and trying to get a bond for the well prior to approval. I have talked with Mr Garman several times and have written numerous letters requesting bond but as yet I haven't been successful.

I am enclosing the SG101 for this well which is dated September 6, 1932, altho the well was not started until December 8th, 1932. This well is located in Sec. 9, T. 14 S., R. 25 E. The other well that was started about a year ago was in Sec. 15, T. 14 S., R. 25 E. and it has already been plugged and abandoned. Your files should have all of the reports on this well, but in case you don't have them please advise me and I will make copies for you.

Mr. Garman absolutely ignores letters and when you talk with him he will promise anything. I am just about out of ideas as to what course to try next on this fellow. You might write him threatening court action if he doesn't do something at once. If you have any suggestions to make I will be glad to try and carry them out.

Please advise what course you wish followed in this case and I will do my best to get that bond.
