DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was drilled to 8099' in lime and chert and plugged back with cement to 5000'. No commercial oil or gas production was encountered in any of the zones tested.

Plugging of the well was done in the following manner:

Hole was filled with 12# mud from P.B. depth of 5000' to 1480'. Plugged back with cement from 1480' to 1200'. Hole filled with 12# mud from 1200' to 250'. Cemented from 250' to surface. 4' marker was erected and location restored to its original condition.

No casing was pulled from the hole.
