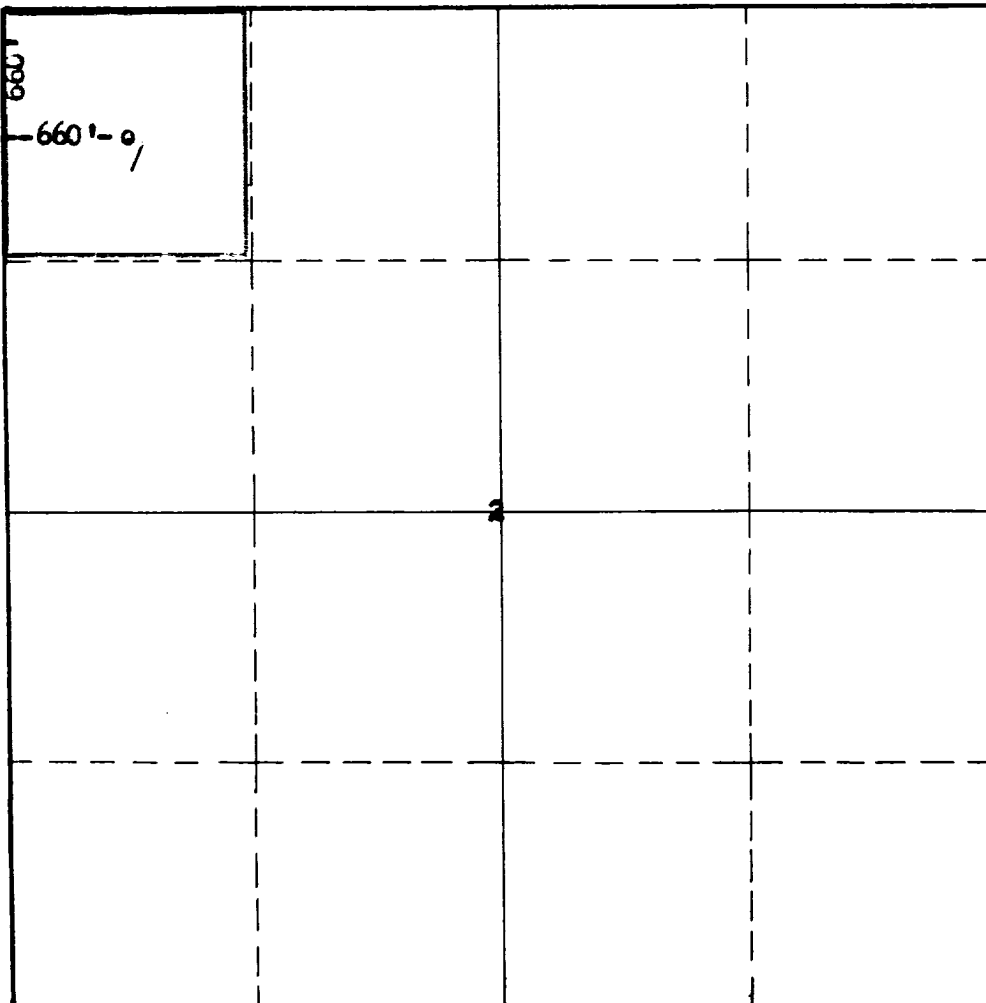

Dear Mr. Hunt,

This will acknowledge receipt of form C-101 (Notice of Intention to Drill) on the above mentioned well. However, the forms submitted are old forms and we are unable to accept them. Inclosed are revised forms C-101 & C-125. Please submit six (6) copies of form C-101 accompanied by three (3) copies of form C-125.

Before form C-101 (Notice of Intention to Drill) is approved by the commission, an operator drilling on state or privately on land must first submit a plugging bond for approval. This may be either a one-well bond (in the amount of \$5,000.00), or a \$10,000.00 blanket bond, which permits the drilling of any number of wells.

You will also need to contact the N. M. State Engineers, in Roswell, New Mexico and have them approve your casing program as subject well is in the Artesian Water Basin.
