DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

Expect to drill with rotary tools to about 750 feet, or top of the lime, and set 8" casing, then change to cable tools and drill to about 1229' or the Rogers oil formation, in the event water is encountered after the 8" casing is set the hole will be under-reamed and the 8" carried on down to shut off the water and water formation mudded off. If the Rogers oil formation is encountered expect to set 6 5/8" casing and tubing and treat formation with acid.
