The well is located 510 ft. N of N line and 660 ft. E of E line of sec. 15The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3487 ft.

DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudlogging jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

Oil showing encountered at 1251', drilling continued to 1283' with more or less saturation to bottom of hole in very hard lime formation. By bailing hole showed to be making about 2 barrels of oil in 24 hours. On August 3rd well was acidized with 1000 gals. of Dowell XX acid, after cleaning out well showed to be making about 3 barrels of oil daily. On August 9th well was again treated with 1000 gals. of acid which increased oil to about 5 barrels daily. On August 13th well was shot with 100 qts. of nitroglycerin from 1250' to 1280' using 4 1/2" shell, after cleaning out and testing well showed to be making about 8 barrels of oil daily. On August 17th well was again shot with 120 qts. of nitroglycerin from 1250' to 1280', cleaning out hole at this date.
