Proposals subject to U.S.G.S. approval:

1. Ascertain total depth (wire line or strap tubing).
2. Call Mr. Feldmiller, U.S.G.S.
3. Circulate with water or mud to total depth with 2" tubing until satisfactory for cementing.
4. Cement 25 sacks to total depth and 10 pound mud in interval from total depth cement plug to ground level minus 10 feet.
5. Cement 5 sacks from ground level minus 10 feet to ground level and mark with 4" plus steel marker with 4' above ground level according to Rule 202 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
