This office is in receipt of your C-127 requesting a 2 barrel a day allowable for the above captioned wells.

Our proration schedule already shows the Kelly A #1 with an allowable of 1 barrel of oil per day, and the Chaves P #2, with an allowable of 3 barrels of oil per day.

If you are requesting an increase in your allowable, we will need a Form C-103 showing what was done to increase production on the above mentioned wells. If the wells have been shut-in, we will still need a C-103 showing what was done to put the wells back into production.
