
DeKalb has re-worked and deepened the above referred to well to a total depth of 801 feet. We Water-fraced with 20,000 Gallons of Water and 10,000# Sand. A new Potential was taken May 18, 1958 of 7.5 bbls. per day. This is an increase in production of approximately 6 barrels per day.

We have filed with the Oil Conservation Commission at Artesia, Form C-103, C-104, C-105 and C-110.

We would like an increase in allowable on this well and please advise if you desire any other information.
