## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Cactus Well No. 1  
in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 14, Twp. 10 S, Rge. 26 E, N. M. P. M.,  
Oil Field, Chaves County. We plan to commence work on or about  
April 3rd, 19 30.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

The well is a dry hole.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

Drilled to the Glorietta Sands, 2283 ft. -  
Salt Water.

The work we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Pull Casing, leaving one joint in the hole, and  
Plug by replacing all cuttings.
