FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We intend to run 200' of 10-3/4" pipe - mud it thoroughly and test for water shut off - encountered so much water at 130' and 140' that it seems advisable to shut it off in order to expedite drilling.

It is our intention to reduce the size of the hole to 10" at 200' and run a string of 8" casing in the top of the line at approximately 1400' in order to assure a dry hole for drilling into possible pay zones of the San Andres.
