FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Present total depth - 1940'. 1 1/2" boiler new down. Water encountered at 1875' and an additional amount at 1918'.

We plan to go out this water with 10" casing - 11" casing and hole to be set at the cement plug - pull the 7" pipe down 740' of 7" - cement plug to be set at 920' - 7" casing with 10" casing at 740' - casing and to be tested between 760' and 780' and 900' to 915' - no water encountered in this interval. will shoot the pack sand, clean out and test.
