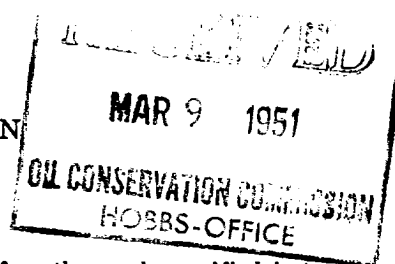

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We plugged off the San Andres dolomite with the top of the plug at 1400' using gravel and 10 sacks of cement - then tried to cement 700' of 7" as per last notice.

Inasmuch as this depth would have meant cementing in the salt section and the first attempt was unsuccessful we propose and are cementing 585' of 7" with 50 sacks and will clean out and test the Queen Sand between 760' and 780' and at 900' to 925' - inasmuch as both these sections showed considerable saturation we will shoot and clean out and if satisfactory results are obtained will run 5½" to the top of the first pay and cement using liner with perforations and sand trap above the bottom pay. I hope.
