DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 1940' - plugged back to 1400' with gravel and 10 sacks of cement - this operation completely successful resulting in scaling off the San Andres tag section previously encountered between 1840' and 1940' in which sulphur water had been encountered.

Cemented 7" at 585' with 50 sacks of cement - completely dry hole between 585' and 1400'. Shot 905' to 920' with 15 quarts - shot 760' to 780' with 50 quarts - not even a rainbow of oil.
