

11. OTHER INFORMATION.

- A. Topography: The land surface in the vicinity of the wellsite is fairly flat. The immediate area of the wellsite is discussed above in paragraph 9B.
- B. Flora and Fauna: The vegetation cover consists of Bush-Mesquite, a scattering of Sideoat Grama, Needle Grass, and miscellaneous wild flowers.
- C. The Pecos River is approximately four miles west of proposed location.
- D. There are no inhabited dwellings within a mile of the vicinity.
- E. Surface Ownership: The wellsite is on private surface and federal minerals.
- F. There is no evidence of any archaeological, historical or cultural sites in the area.


