DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

This well was drilled to 2954' in sand and lime with no evidence of commercial production. It was cored from 1752-1810'; 1850-1900'; 1900-1943'; 1955-1985'. The well was also logged. Since no shows were encountered, verbal approval was received to plug to abandon. It is proposed to plug as follows: Load hole with mud laden fluid; spot 10 sack plug from 2954' to 2932'; spot 30 sack plug 2315'-2330'; spot 20 sack plug from 1150' to 1215'; spot 15 sack plug from 380'-410' and a 10 sack plug to surface with a 4"-4' marker bull plugged to designate the abandoned location. Celler and pits will be filled, the location cleared of all debris and levelled in a workmanlike manner.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
