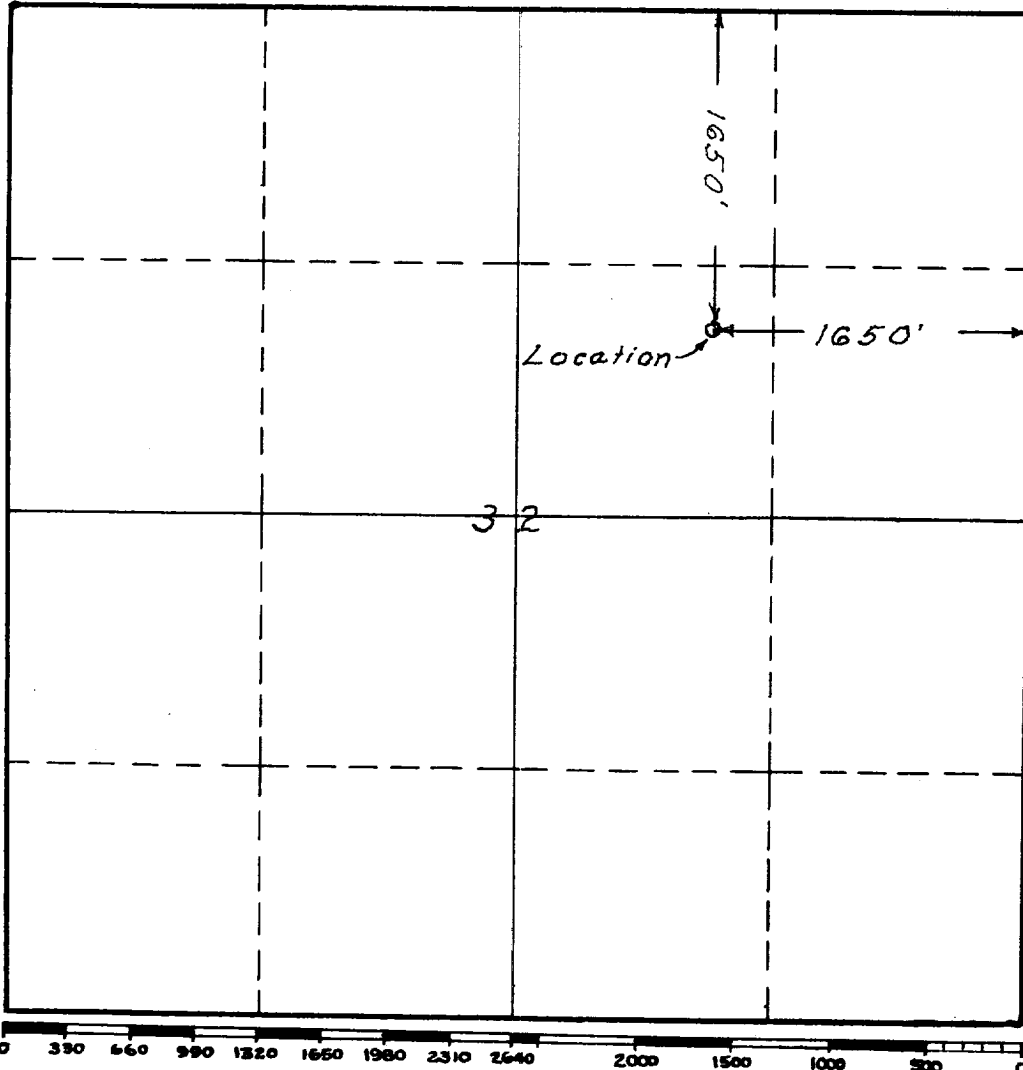

This will acknowledge receipt of form C-101 (Notice of Intention to Drill) on the above-captioned well. We are returning this form so that you can correct your proposed casing program. It will be necessary for you to obtain your surface casing program from the State Engineer's Office, P. O. Box 810, Roswell, New Mexico. (This well is located in the water basin.) I believe they will want 50 sacks of cement behind the 300 feet of 8 5/8-inch casing. If the well is productive we will ask you to run at least enough pipe to reach 50 feet into the San Andres lime, cementing with at least 50 sacks.

It will be necessary for you to obtain your own casing program from the State Engineer's Office, P. O. Box 220, Roswell, New Mexico. (This well is located in the water basin.) I believe they will want 50 sacks of cement behind the 300 feet of 1 7/8-inch casing. If the well is productive we will ask you to run at least enough pipe to reach 50 feet into the San Andres line, cementing with at least 50 sacks.
