DETAILS OF WORK

Hole was filled with heavy mud and a 10-sack plug of cement was placed from 3600-51'. 7" casing was parted at about 3600' and a total of 3620' of casing was recovered. Another 10-sack plug of cement was placed at the surface inside of 10-3/4" casing and a 4" pipe marker was left 4' out of ground. Location was cleaned and levelled. Abandonment was completed February 10, 1951.
