DETAILS OF WORK

Hole was plugged and abandoned on Jan. 3, 1962, as follows:

Hole was filled with heavy mud. 5 sacks of cement were spotted from 2126 to 2076'. Cut 4 1/2" casing at 1108' and pulled. Following plugs were placed.

23 sacks of cement 1133-1083'.

40 sacks of cement 950- 900'.

74 sacks of cement 700- 610'.

40 sacks of cement 250- 200'.

6 sacks of cement at surface.

A 4" pipe marker was cemented at surface. Location has been cleaned, pits filled and is now ready for final inspection.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
