DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

13 3/8" casing was cemented at depth of 408' with 300 sacks on July 7, 1949. Cement was circulated back into cellar and allowed a set time of 24 hours. Casing was then entered with drill pipe and tested for leaks. Cement job was found to be O.K. and drilling was resumed in a 12 1/4" hole.
