## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A temperature survey was run on September 3, 1949 and top of cement behind 7" casing was found at 4030'. Top of cement inside 7" casing was found at 6000'.

Cement was allowed a set time of 72 hours and tubing was then run in hole, with bit, and casing was tested with 800#. Same was found to be O K. Cement was then drilled from casing; shoe drilled; and hole washed to bottom.
