Acidized thru 3" tubing with formation packer set at 1955' - acidized pay zone 1975-1990 T.D. with 250 gallons - swabbed out and acidized with 750 gallons - packer failed - unable to swab satisfactorily so pulled tubing and bailed finally getting all the water out of the well at 11 A.M. Sept. 30th - shut in for four hours - bailed approx. 1 bbl. of clean oil - no water.
