## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" casing was run to 2218 feet and cemented with 600 sax. A temperature survey showed the top of the cement to be  $\pm$  870 feet. The casing was perforated at the top of the cement in the annulus and recemented with 750 sax. Cement was circulated to the surface.
