Hole was at 1,006' T.D. cemented by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company with 150 sacks. Circulated cement to surface. Allowed to set 36 hours. Perforated casing with 4 shots per foot from 904' to 973'. Allowed well to stand for 12 hours. Tested a few gallons of oil and no water.
