We are very sorry that all of our forms sent in in connection with the completion of our Well No. 1-A on our New Mexico State "A" Lease located in the SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 11, Township 11, South, Range 27, East, Chaves County, New Mexico, were incomplete. In accordance with your letter of October 6, 1959, we now enclose you corrected Form C-104 and three (3) copies each of Form No. C-103 on the setting of 9-5/8" surface casing and 7" oil string. We hope you will find these reports in correct form.

In this connection, we have never had better luck drilling and cementing casing in well than the four wells we have drilled on this lease. In each instance, we have pushed cement back to the surface and have had no leaks of any kind and no water showed in the bottom of the hole on extensive tests after each well.
