## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Lost circulation was encountered at 402 feet. The lost circulation zone contained salt water flowing in an underground current. This current made it impossible to regain circulation by cementing or any other method. The rig was skidded 10 feet south and a new hole drilled large enough to set 13-3/8" casing at  $\pm$  500 feet to case off the lost circulation zone. The new casing program is as follows:

13-3/8" 54# casing to be set at  $\pm$  500 feet with  $\pm$  475 sack cement8-5/8" 32# casing to be set at  $\pm$  2200 feet with  $\pm$  750 sack cement5-1/2" 17# casing to be set at  $\pm$  6500 feet with  $\pm$  600 sack cement
