



Well was drilled to 2200 feet. 8-5/8" casing was set at 2190 feet and cemented with 200 sac cement. Casing was tested by holding 1000 pounds of pressure on it for 30 minutes. There was no pressure drop. Well is now dilling below 2200 feet.
