FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

A 7-7/8" hole was drilled to 6512 feet. The well was then cored to total depth of 6556 feet. Top of pay from electric log data is at 6500 feet. 5-1/2" casing was set at 6499 feet and cemented with 500 sack cement. The casing will be tested during the morning of June 6, 1950. If results of casing tests are satisfactory, the well will be swabbed clean and acidized with \pm 6,000 gallons of acid.
