Form C-104 is to be submitted in triplicate to the Commission Office, to which Form C-101 was sent. Two copies will be retained there and the other submitted to the Proration Office, Hobbs, New Mexico. The allowable will be assigned effective 7:00 A. M., on date of completion. The completion date shall be that date in the case of an oil well, when oil is delivered into the stock tanks.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5-1/2 inch casing was set at 6499 feet and cemented with 500 sax. After cement had set forty-eight hours, the casing was tested with 1000 psi pressure for thirty minutes. There was no pressure drop. After plug was drilled, the well was swabbed for twenty-four hours. No water developed during the swabbing tests, indicating a successful shut-off.
