## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" casing was set at 2197' and cemented with 900 sack cement. After cement had set 56 hours a pressure of 1000 psi was applied to the casing for 30 minutes. There was no pressure drop at the end of the 30-minute period, indicating the casing to be OK. Plug was then drilled.
