## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Started rigging up rotary October 28, 1949. Well was spudded October 31.  
13-3/8" casing was set at 141 feet and cemented with 500 sac on November 2.  
Casing was tested with 500 pounds and held. Started drilling ahead November 3.  
Well is now drilling at 1816 feet.
