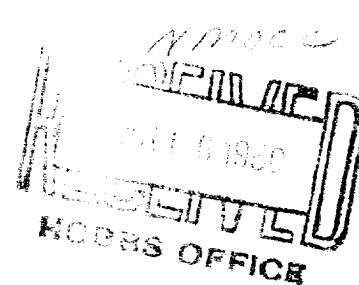

Washed pay section from 6490 to 6563' with 500 gallons of acid. Ran 2" tubing with packer to 6560'. Packer set at 6450' in the 7" casing. Acidized well with 2000 gallons and 5000 gallons in two stages. Well now swabbing and flowing an estimated 20 barrels of oil per hour.
