RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE YEAR 1960

The Commission on the Status of Women, created by the Executive Order of the President in 1953, has the honor to submit to the President and the Congress its report on the status of women in the United States for the year 1960. The Commission was organized to study the problems of women in the United States and to make recommendations for their solution. It has held numerous public hearings and has received many suggestions from women's organizations and individuals. The Commission has also conducted extensive research into the various fields of women's status, including education, employment, and family life. The following are the Commission's recommendations for the year 1960:
