The Bureau of Plant Industry, United States Department of Agriculture, was organized on July 1, 1905, by the transfer of the plant industry functions of the United States Forest Service to the Department of Agriculture. The Bureau has been organized into three divisions: the Division of Plant Industry, the Division of Plant Quarantine, and the Division of Plant Pathology.
