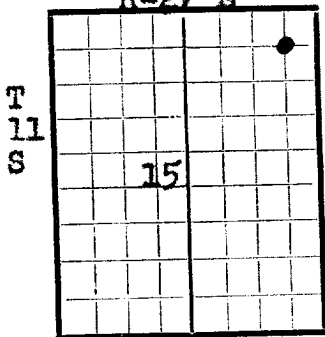

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL

Well No.: 2-X A

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 15, T. 11 S., R. 27 E., N.M.P.M.

The DeKalb Agricultural Association, Inc., caused a test well, known as No. 2-X, for oil and gas to be commenced in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 15, T. 11 S., R. 27 E., N.M.P.M., on or about December 3, 1949, and said well was drilled with cable tools to a depth of 1,990 feet, the operation thereon having been continuous since the commencement of said well to the date hereof. Considerable mechanical difficulty was encountered in connection with the drilling of said well, and in order to shut off water and to test a showing of oil the well was plugged back to a depth of 1,970 feet with lead wool; the hole is crooked and is off more than 6° from vertical, and in order to carry the well deeper with rotary equipment, it would be necessary to pull the casing and to ream the hole and to drill out the lead wool, which would be a more expensive operation than starting a new hole and drilling the same with rotary equipment to the objective of approximately 6,600 feet. Because of the fact that the drilling of the new well in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 15 in lieu of the above mentioned well, the new well has been designated as No. 2-X A.
