Re: Fences for tank bottom
disposal pits

Dear Dr. Copelan:

During a recent field inspection of the Coyote-Queen Pool I noticed that you were having tankage built for your Pan American State Well No. 1, Unit C, Sec. 27-11S-27E, and that there was a tank bottom disposal pit nearby. At that time a fence around the tank was about half completed, but I noticed no fence around the disposal pit as required by Rule 313, Commission Rules and Regulations. Since we have received several complaints from the rancher about unfenced pits in this pool, I thought I should mention this situation to you. Further, I noted that there was no sign on the well as required by Rule 103.
