DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Plugging was done September 5, 1949, after obtaining approval from Justin Newman in telephone conversation with A. L. Pierce, tool pusher for Carper Drilling Company. Hole was loaded with 10#/gal. mud from 7580' to surface. A 20 sack cement plug was spotted at 1380'. A 5 sack cement plug was placed at the surface and a regulation marker set. 1405 feet of 8-5/8" casing was left in hole.
