To plug and abandon well by placing cement plugs from 7245' to 7045' (Ellenberger), from 6928 to 6828' (Devonian), from 4653' to 4553' (bottom of 7-5/8" csg.), from 531' to 431' (bottom of 10-3/4" csg.) and from 100' to surface. Approximately 600' of 7-5/8" casing will be recovered. Regulation marker will be installed at well.
