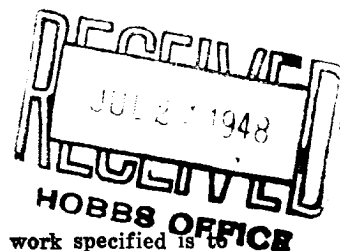

Fill with heavy mud from 2886 to 2575, then spot 8 sax cement and fill hole with heavy mud to 320 feet and set a plug of 8 sax cement, then fill hole with heavy mud to the surface and set regulation marker. We intend to fill the cellar and pits and level the land as we found it.
