DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On or about July 20th, 1948, Atha Exploration, Lightcap, #2, was plugged and abandoned in the following manner: The bottom of the hole was at 2886'. The hole was filled to a depth of 2575' where a plug of 8 sacks of cement was set. The hole was filled with heavy mud to a depth of 320' where 8 sacks of cement was set. The hole was then filled to the surface where a regulation marker was set with 5 sacks of cement. This process was in accordance with instructions of the Commission office.
