The subject well has been plugged and abandoned as a dry hole. Cement plugs were set as follows: 60 sack plug 7695-7550', 40 sack plug 7300-7200', 40 sack plug 6900-6800', 40 sack plug 6230-6130', 50 sack plug 2725-2640', 30 sack plug 2190-2070', 45 sack plug from 50' to surface. Recovered approximately 1090' of 7" casing and approximately 500' of 9 5/8" casing. A 4" marker was erected at surface and the location was restored to its original condition. Date plugging started 2-27-57. Date plugging completed 3-2-57.
